



Decision No 1/2022
of 15 March 2022
of the Management Board
concerning the establishment of a Liaison Office of the European Labour
Authority in Brussels

THE EUROPEAN LABOUR AUTHORITY,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2019/1149 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 establishing a European Labour Authority, amending Regulations (EC) No 883/2004, (EU) No 492/2011, and (EU) 2016/589 and repealing Decision (EU) 2016/344 (“the founding Regulation” and “the Authority”), and in particular Article 14 and Article 22(5) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The Executive Director presented the intention to establish the Liaison Office in Brussels.
- (2) The liaison office of the Authority in Brussels should contribute to the strategic governance and outreach activities of the ELA towards its stakeholders at EU level.
- (3) The scope of the activities to be carried out by the Liaison Office in Brussels should include in particular the strengthening of the impact and visibility of the Authority at EU level by deepening cooperation with EU institutions, monitoring and feedback on EU policy making, broadening of cooperation with European-level social partners and broadening cooperation with EU agencies and EUAN office in Brussels.
- (4) The activities of the Liaison Office in Brussels should not duplicate administrative functions of the Authority. The costs incurred should be appropriate to the scope of the activities to be carried out by the Liaison Office in Brussels.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

Liaison Office of the European Labour Authority in Brussels

The Management Board agrees with the establishment of a Liaison Office of the European Labour Authority in Brussels.

Article 2

Entry into force

This Decision shall take effect on the day following that of its adoption.
