Malcolm joined ELA in January 2021 as a Labour Mobility Officer. He was promoted to Head of the Cooperation Support Unit in May 2021. With over 20 years of experience in EU social security coordination and labour mobility, he is an expert in his field. He has worked with European Commission DG EMPL as a Seconded National Expert from 2018 to 2020, where he was involved in the revision of Regulations (EC) No 883/2004 and 987/2009, mainly on the chapters of applicable legislation and unemployment benefits.

From 2003 to 2017, he was employed in the Maltese public service where he held various positions, including Director responsible for social security international relations.
