

Decision No 05/2025 of 16 June 2025 of the Management Board on the extension of ELA Executive Director's term of office

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2019/1149 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 establishing the European Labour Authority ("the Authority") amending Regulations (EC) No 883/2004, (EU) No 492/2011, and (EU) 2016/589 and repealing Decision (EU) 2016/344, and in particular Article 18(n), 21(1), 30 and 31(1), (5) and (8) therein;

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union (hereinafter referred to as the 'Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union (hereinafter reffered to as the 'CEOS') laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC No 259/68), and in particular to Articles 5 7 43, 44 and 46of the Staff Regulations and Articles 2(a), 8-10, 20and 47 of the CEOS;

Having Regard to Decision No 1/2019 of the Management Board of the European Labour Authority of 17 October 2019 on the Rules of Procedure of the Management Board of the European Labour Authority, and in particular Article 7(2) therein;

Whereas:

- (1) In conformity with Article 18(n) and 31 of Regulation (EU) 2019/1149, Mr Cosmin BOIANGIU was appointed Executive Director of the European Labour Authority for a term of five year, as of 16 December 2020, by Decision No 14/2020 of the Management Board of the European Labour Authority of 10 December 2020.
- (2) On 6 May 2025, the European Commission decided to propose to the Management Board the extension of the term of office of the Executive Director pursuant to Article 31(4) of Regulation (EU) 2019/1149, based on the assessment of the Authority's future tasks and challenges, including the evaluation of the Executive Directors' performance.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Executive Director's term of office is extended for a duration of five (5) years, starting as of 16 December 2025.

Article 3

This decision	shall enter	into force	on the day	/ following	j its adop	tion.
