

Decision No 14/2025 of 26 November 2025

of the Management Board

on the adoption of Guidelines for Concerted and Joint Inspections

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN LABOUR AUTHORITY,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2019/1149 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 establishing a European Labour Authority, amending Regulations (EC) No 883/2004, (EU) No 492/2011, and (EU) 2016/589 and repealing Decision (EU) 2016/3441 ("the Founding Regulation" and "the Authority"), and in particular Article 17(1)(a), and Article 8 thereof;

Having regard to the Decision of the Management Board 8/2019 on setting up the Working Group on Inspections as amended by Management Board Decision 15/2024, in particular Article 2 thereof.

WHEREAS:

- 1. According to Article 8(1), the Authority should coordinate the and support cross-border inspection at the request of one or more Member States or may also, on its own initiative, suggest to the authorities of the Member States concerned that they carry out a concerted or joint inspection. Social partners organisations at national level may bring cases to the attention of the Authority.
- The Working Group on inspections agreed on the guidelines for Member States and social partners organisation on how to prepare for, organise, carry out and follow-up on cross-border inspections supported and coordinated by the European Labour Authority.
- 3. The guidelines should be approved by the Management Board.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Guidelines for Concerted and Joint Inspections annexed to this decision are hereby approved.
