



**Decision No 08/2026
of 06 May 2026
of the Management Board**

on the application by analogy of Commission Decision C(2026)634 of 5 February 2026, amending Decision C(2002)98 fixing the rates of the daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursements of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN LABOUR AUTHORITY,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2019/1149 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019, establishing the European Labour Authority amending Regulations (EC) No 883/2004, (EU) No 492/2011, and (EU) 2016/589 and repealing Decision (EU) 2016/344¹, and in particular Articles 30, 31, 32 and 33 thereof,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union, laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/681, and in particular Articles 13(2), point (b), and 13a of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations and Articles 22 and 92 of the Conditions of Employment of Other Servant,

Having regard to Commission Decision C(2002)98 of 16 January 2002, fixing the rates of the daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursements of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union,

Having regard to communication C(2014)6543 final of 26 September 2014 from Vice-President Šefčovič to the Commission on the guidelines on the implementation of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations with regard to the implementing rules applicable in the agencies, and in particular section 3.1 thereof,

After consulting the Staff Committee,

Whereas:

- (1) According to Regulation (EU) 2019/1149, Staff Regulations and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union apply to the staff of the European Labour Authority.
- (2) Pursuant to Article 22 of the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants, subject to Articles 23 to 26, a member of the temporary staff shall be entitled, in accordance with Articles 5 to 15 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations, to reimbursement of expenses incurred by him on taking up appointment, transfer or leaving the service, and also to

reimbursement of expenses incurred in the course of or in connection with the performance of his duties.

- (3) Pursuant to Articles 13(2), point (b) and 13a of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations, the scale for missions in countries outside the European territory of the Member States shall be fixed and adjusted periodically by the Appointing Authority. Detailed rules shall be laid down by the appointing authorities of the various institutions under the general implementing provisions.
- (4) Commission Decision C(2002)98 of 16 January 2002 amended the general provisions for the implementation of Article 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations fixing the daily allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursement of hotel expenses in order to reflect changes in prices and exchange rates recorded at the different places of mission outside the European Union.
- (5) On 6 March 2026, the Commission informed the European Labour Authority that it has adopted Commission Decision C(2026)634 amending Commission Decision C(2002)98, in order to include the daily subsistence allowance and hotel ceiling for missions taking place in the United Kingdom.
- (6) Pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations, implementing rules applicable to the Commission shall apply by analogy to the Authority nine months after the date of the notification from the Commission of 13 September 2019, or enter into force at an earlier date as per subparagraph 2 of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Commission Decision C(2026)634, amending Commission Decision C(2002)98 as reproduced in Annex I to this Decision and modifying the rates of the daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursement of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union, as set out in Annex I, is hereby formally adopted by the European Labour Authority.

Article 2

This Decision shall take effect on the day following its adoption and it shall apply from that date, without awaiting the expiry of the nine-month period after which it would otherwise become applicable by analogy.
