



**Decision No 11/2026**  
**of 06 May 2026**  
**of the Management Board**  
**on the Designation of the reporting officers for the annual appraisal procedures**  
**of the Executive Director of the European Labour Authority**

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN LABOUR AUTHORITY,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2019/1149 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 establishing a European Labour Authority, amending Regulations (EC) No 883/2004, (EU) No 492/2011, and (EU) 2016/589 and repealing Decision (EU) 2016/344<sup>1</sup>,

Having regard to Decision 7/2020 of the Management Board of the European Labour Authority of 24 March 2020 concerning the annual appraisal, probationary and management trial period of the Executive Director, and in particular Article 3 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The Management Board shall designate three reporting officers from among its members, including one representative from the European Commission, for the purpose of the annual appraisal of the Executive Director.
- (2) Reporting officers cannot be designated to any other function within the appraisal procedures of the Executive Director of the Authority.
- (3) The Chairperson of the Management Board shall act as appeal assessor.
- (4) In the interest of clarity and legal certainty, Decision No 17/2023 of the Management Board on the designation of the reporting officers for the annual appraisal procedures of the Executive Director of the European Labour Authority should be repealed accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

**Article 1**

The following members are designated as reporting officers for the annual appraisal procedures of the Executive Director of the European Labour Authority:

- (1) Ms Vita BALIUKEVIČIENĖ,

**Article 3**

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following its adoption.
